Masada, Qumran (Dead Sea Scrolls) and Dead Sea

Wednesday June 10th



Depart Jerusalem 8:00 a.m. and descend through the beautiful scenery of the Judean Desert to the lowest point on Earth - the Dead Sea. Drive along the sea, pass by Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found and continue to Masada - ascend via cable car to the ancient fortress built by Herod the Great in the 1st Century B.C.E. which was the last Jewish stronghold during the revolt against the Romans.



Bring water, hat, walking shoes, bathing suit & towel (there will be time for a dip in the Dead Sea). Lunch not included. Return to Jerusalem.

The Western Wall Tunnels

During a fascinating tour of the Western Wall Tunnels – Hidden layers of the Wall are revealed underground. They tell the story of ancient Jerusalem and of generations of longing for it. The tour takes approximately an hour and 15 minutes.
